Red Eye Multiplier High Hands Official Rules & Regulations

- The promotion starts February 1, 2018, and ends March 29, 2018.
- Players capable of providing a Marquee Rewards® Card that is playing in a non-tournament, promotional eligible poker game in the Poker Room qualify.
- The promotion period will run from 11:59 PM until 5:59 AM.
- Winners are declared and payments made after each hour block within the promotional period. The first payment will be made at 1:00 AM and the final payment will be made at 5:59 AM.
- The number of eligible cash games open at the beginning of the hour will determine the
 payout for that hour's promotional period. The hourly cash amount will be \$50 for each
 promotional eligible cash game. Example: 5 eligible cash games at 1AM = \$250 payout at
 2AM. 10 eligible cash games at 2am = \$500 payout at 3am.
- A countdown timer will be displayed in the room for each promotional period. Once the
 countdown timer reaches zero (0), the player with the high hand of the hour will receive
 the designated prize. In the event, a hand is completed, and a supervisor is called to verify
 the hand before the timer reaches zero (0), the hand will qualify for the current hour. In the
 event the supervisor is called after the timer reaches zero (0) and there is a subsequent
 promotional period, the hand will be considered the starting high hand of the new hour.
- Players must play their hands independently. If any player, whether directly or indirectly
 involved in the hand, passes information or instructs another on how to act or reveals their
 hand to other players, the promotion will be disqualified from that table.
- Must be present after the hour in which the high hand was made to win. Players will have 3 minutes to claim the prize.
- Only the highest hand of the hour will be eligible to win the prize for the hour. If the patron
 that had made the highest hand of the hour has left or no hand were made during that hour,
 the prize would roll over to the next hour. Prizes will not roll over from one promotion day
 to the next.
- The first hand of a full house or higher made by any player at an eligible table with a minimum of a \$20 pot and wins the pot, will be posted as the initial high hand of each hour of the promotion.
- A player must use both cards from his/her hand and win the hand to qualify.
- A list will be kept by a Poker Supervisor to record the current high hand of the hour, as well as the name, table, and seat number of the player with the highest current hand for that hour.
- Any time a higher hand is made, the dealer will announce "high hand" and alert the Poker Supervisor that a hand higher than the current hand listed on the sheet has been made.
- Simultaneous ties will result in an even split of the prize money. Any subsequent hand
 must beat the current high hand to be eligible to win the prize. A subsequent tie of the
 current listed high hand is not eligible to share in the prize money.
- A Poker Supervisor or above will verify the hand visually and then add it to the list as the current high hand for the hour, crossing off the previous high hand.
- A Promotion Log will be kept for this promotion, which will include all times within the promotional period, for every day of the promotion.
- All payouts for this promotion will come from the Poker Room's Promotional Fund.
