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HOLLYWOOD CASINO COLUMBUS LETTER CARRIERS CHARITY TOURNAMENT **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

No Limit Texas Hold'Em Tournament \$135 Buy-In + Optional \$15 Add-on \$135 Entry Fee (\$55 Prize Pool + \$55 Charity + \$25 Admin)

1. Date/Days: Sunday August 26, 2018 2. Start Time: 12:15 PM

- 3. Tournament Format: This event will be played in a No-Limit Texas Hold'Em Tournament. There will be 5-10 players per table. Tables will be consolidated as players are eliminated from the tournament.
- 4. Limit of Players: Minimum of 20 entries and a maximum of 300 entries plus 200 late entries and alternates for a total of 500 entries will be allowed until the end of the
- re-entry period.
 5. Tournament Structure: 15 minutes per blind level and each player begins play with 7,000 chips and can increase their total starting chips to 10,000 by purchasing an optional add-on prior to taking their first hand. See Exhibit A for complete tournament structure.

6. Tournament Guarantee: This tournament does not have a guaranteed prize pool.

7. Registration Process: Sign-up begins at 11:15 AM until the event start time. Late registration or re-entry will be allowed until the end of level 8. Players will be able to register for Tournament events on the same day as the event only. Registration will be done by the tournament cashier at the poker podium and/or cashier cage. Marquee Rewards Club cards are required for the registration of this event. All participants must be at least 21 years of age.

8. Tournament Fees: \$135 (\$110 Entry Fee + \$25 admin fee) Participants in the

"Charity Tournament" accept 50% (\$55) of the entry fee will be donated from the

prize pool.

9. Optional Add-On: Players will receive an additional 3,000 chips for an optional \$15

- gratuity.

 10. Charity Event: The tournament is designed as part of a charity event for the Letter Carriers. Our charity will be Muscular Dystrophy Association Tax ID# 13-1665552. The tournament will have a buy-in associated with it and all players that participate in the event will have a paid buy-in that will be split between the tournament prize pool and the charity; 50% to each less the administrative fee.
- 11. Prize Structure: This is a Prize Pool tournament. The prize structure will be based upon the number of players entered in the tournament at the end of the re-entry period. All other entry fees will be paid out in the prize pool excluding the Charity withholding. See Exhibit B.
- 12. Tournament Revenue: Hollywood Casino Columbus will charge an administration fee for all tournaments. The fee schedule for each event will be posted. Total administration fee collected each event will be recorded in the "Bravo Tournament Report" to be submitted to Finance and the Commission.

13. Re-entry Tournaments: Allows players to buy back in to the tournament event once they have been eliminated and their original chips exhausted. Re-entry players will

- be treated as a new player, with a standard starting stack of chips.

 14. Determining Winners: Winners will be determined based on the order they are eliminated from the tournament. A player is eliminated when they no longer have chips remaining.
- 15. Seat assignments: Players will either draw random seat assignments manually or the seat assignments will be randomly drawn by computer when the player registers for the event. A maximum of 10 players will be allowed per table.
- 16. Tournament chips: Non-value tournament chips will be given equally to each player who registers for the event. Quantity will vary for each event. Limits and blinds are raised on an equal time basis throughout the event.
- 17. Tournament Chip Storage: At the conclusion of this tournament, all tournament chips will be reconciled through the "Poker Tournament Chip Log" and a chip discrepancy report will be filed if necessary. Tournament chips will be kept in the Player's Services Cage and will be transported to and from the Poker Room (or Tournament Area in the case of approved special events) by means of a secured rolling cart for such purpose.
- 18. Pot Chopping: Players may chop the prize pool as long as all players agree. If this occurs, it will be documented on the payout schedule with the corrected amount won and all taxes will be withheld accordingly. But if any patron begins a discussion concerning tax avoidance, this will immediately void the ability to chop the pot. Players may not voluntarily chop the prize pool until after the conclusion of the
- 19. Tournament Cancellation: In the event that a tournament has to be changed or cancelled, it will be posted as well as announced in the Poker Room. OCCC must be notified of all such changes or cancellations and why they were necessary. Any monies paid by players for the tournament will be entirely refunded.
