Official Rules & Regulations

1. Date/Days: September 27, 2018 & November 15, 2018
2. Start Time: 7:15 PM
3. Tournament Format: This event will be played in a No-Limit Texas Hold'Em Tournament. There will be 5-10 players per table. Tables will be consolidated as players are eliminated from the tournament.
4. Limit of Players: Minimum of 20 entries and a maximum of 150 entries plus 150 late entries and alternates for a total of 300 entries will be allowed until the end of the re-entry period.
5. Tournament Structure: 15 minutes per round and each player begins play with 20,000 chips and can increase their total starting chips to 25,000 by purchasing an optional add-on prior to taking their first hand. See Exhibit A for complete tournament structure. Players can receive an extra 5,000 in tournament chips an increasing their total chips to 30,000 by donating 5 non-perishable or canned food items; or by donating \$5.00 cash to the Mid-Ohio Food Bank. See Exhibit A for complete tournament structure.
6. Tournament Guarantee: This tournament has a guaranteed prize pool of \$5,000, not including money allocated to the Administration Fee, Leaderboard Fund, and donations. If the tournament does not draw enough players to reach the guaranteed amount, money will be added from (A) the Leaderboard Fund, followed by (B) the Poker Players Promotional Fund, to reach the guaranteed prize pool amount. If these sources have been depleted and the guarantee is still not met, Hollywood Casino Columbus will make up the difference.
7. Registration Process: Sign-up begins at 6:15 PM until the event start time. Late registration or re-entry will be allowed until the end of level 8. Players will be able to register for Tournament events on the same day as the event only. Registration will be done by the tournament cashier at the cashier cage. Marquee Rewards Club cards are required for the registration of this event. All participants must be at least 21 years of age.
8. Tournament Fees: \$75 (\$60 Entry Fee + \$15 Administration Fee)
9. Optional Add-On: Players will receive an additional 5,000 chips for an optional \$10 gratuity.
10. Leaderboard Fund: \$3.00 of each Entry Fee shall be withheld from the Prize Pool and deposited in a Leaderboard Fund by Hollywood Casino Columbus for a Tournament Leaderboard. Players earn points by finishing in money earning positions in poker tournaments. Top point earners shall be awarded prizes through an approved leaderboard. All the funds collected will be returned to the players in the form of cash prizes, special tournament promotions, or tournament guarantees. For more details, see 2018 Leaderboard, HWCPC218.
11. Prize Structure: This is a Prize Pool tournament. All entry fees excluding leaderboard funds will be paid out after the tournament. The prize structure will be based upon the number of players entered in the tournament at the end of the re-entry period. See Exhibit B – Daily Tournament Payout Structure.
12. Tournament Revenue: Hollywood Casino Columbus will charge an administration fee for all tournaments. The fee schedule for each event will be posted. Total administration fee collected each event will be recorded in the "Bravo Tournament Report" to be submitted to Finance and the Commission.
13. Re-entry Tournaments: Allows players to buy back in to the tournament event once they have been eliminated and their original chips exhausted. Re-entry players will be treated as a new player, with a standard starting stack of chips.
14. Determining Winners: Winners will be determined based on the order they are eliminated from the tournament. A player is eliminated when they no longer have chips remaining.
15. Seat assignments: Players will either draw random seat assignments manually or the seat assignments will be randomly drawn by computer when the player registers for the event. A maximum of 10 players will be allowed per table.
16. Tournament chips: Non-value tournament chips will be given equally to each player who registers for the event. Quantity will vary for each event. Limits and blinds are raised on an equal time basis throughout the event.
17. Tournament Chip Storage: After this tournament, all tournament chips will be reconciled through the "Poker Tournament Chip Log" and a chip discrepancy report will be filed if necessary. Tournament chips will be kept in the Player's Services Cage and will be transported to and from the Poker Room (or Tournament Area in the case of approved special events) by means of a secured rolling cart for such purpose.
18. Pot Chopping: Players may chop the prize pool as long as all players agree. If this occurs, it will be documented on the payout schedule with the corrected amount won and all taxes will be withheld accordingly. But if any patron begins a discussion concerning tax avoidance, this will immediately void the ability to chop the pot. Players may not voluntarily chop the prize pool until after the conclusion of the re-entry period.
19. Tournament Cancellation: In the event that a tournament has to be changed or cancelled, it will be posted as well as announced in the Poker Room. OCCC must be notified of all such changes or cancellations and why they were necessary. Any monies paid by players for the tournament will be entirely refunded.
